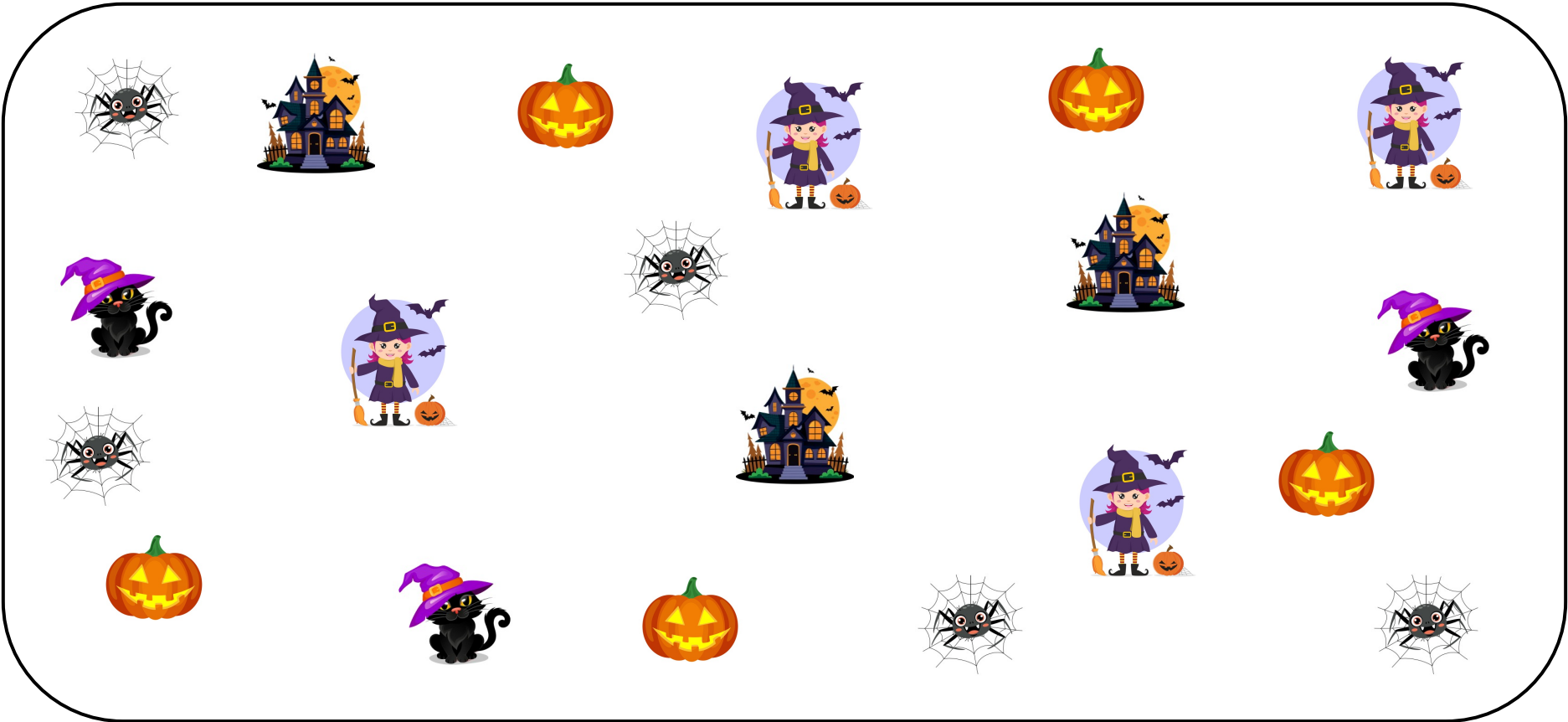


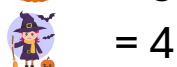
Instructions: Find and count the Halloween pictures

Teacher Tips

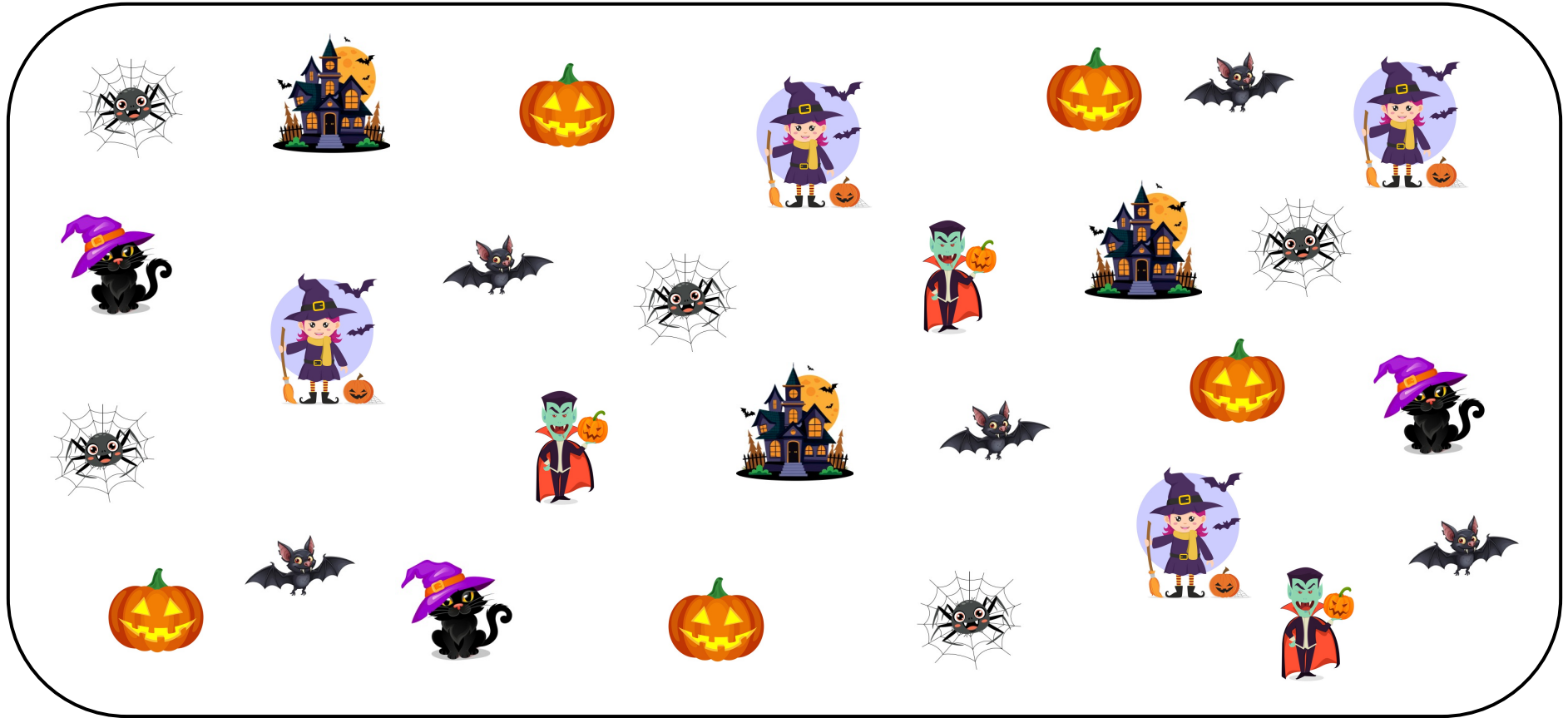
Ask students to point and say the Halloween picture.

- “Find the cat.”
- “Where is the spider?”
- “Show me a pumpkin.”

- Count together as a class.

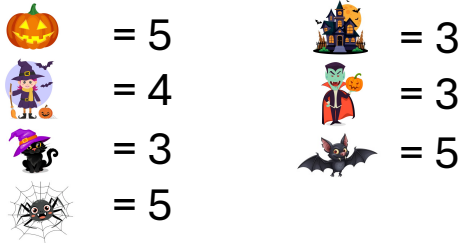
Instructions: Find each picture. Count how many you can see. Write the number in the box.

Teacher Tips

Focus on **counting** and **simple sentences**.

After counting, ask students to say full sentences.

- “I see five pumpkins.”
- “There are three cats.”
- “How many spiders can you see?”

Teacher Tips

Focus on **comparison and critical thinking**.

Ask students to compare the numbers.

- Which object appears the most?
- Which picture appears the least?
- Are there more cats or spiders?
