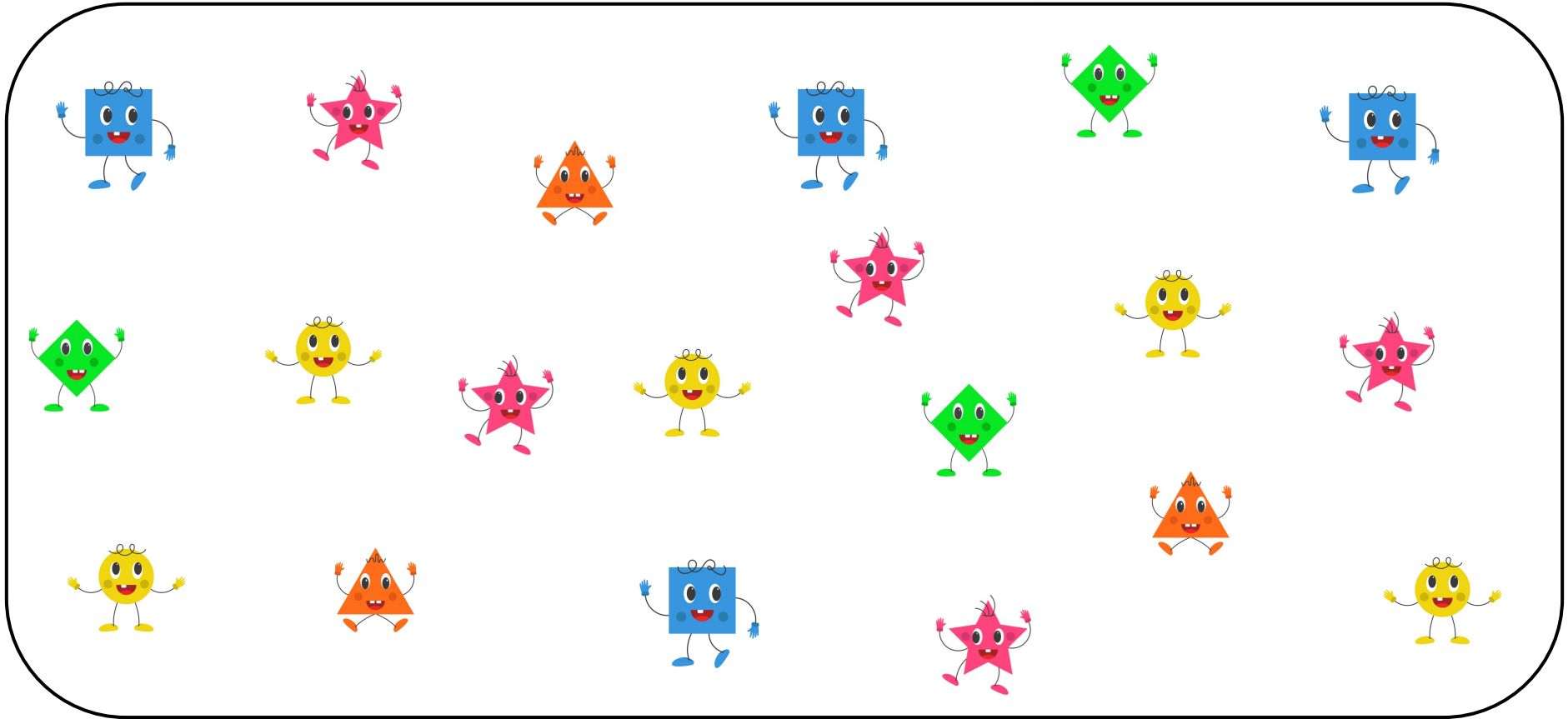


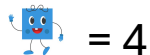
Instructions: Find and count the shapes

Teacher Tips

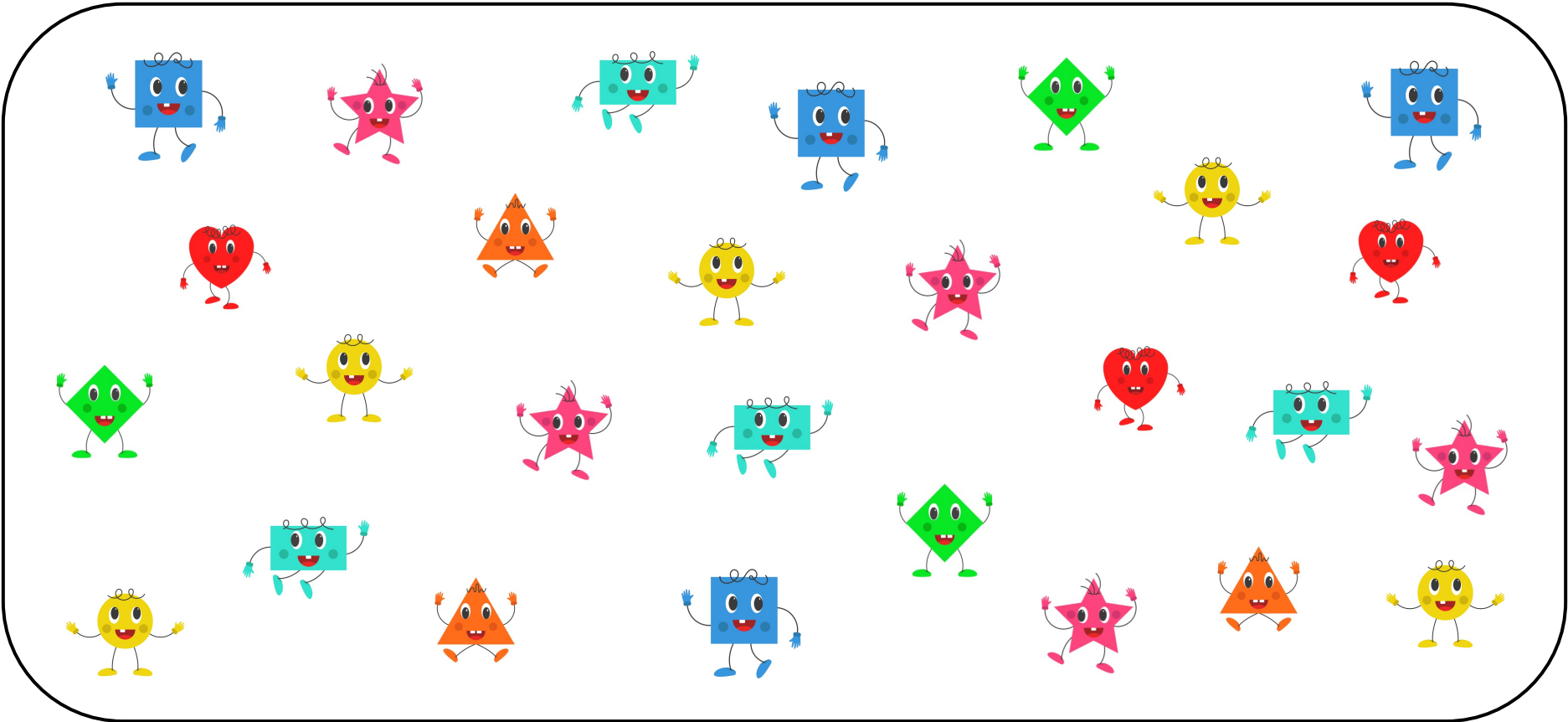
Ask students to point to and say the shape.

- Count together as a class.

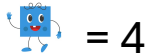
Instructions: Find each shape. Count how many you can see. Write the number in the box.

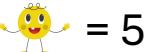

Teacher Tips

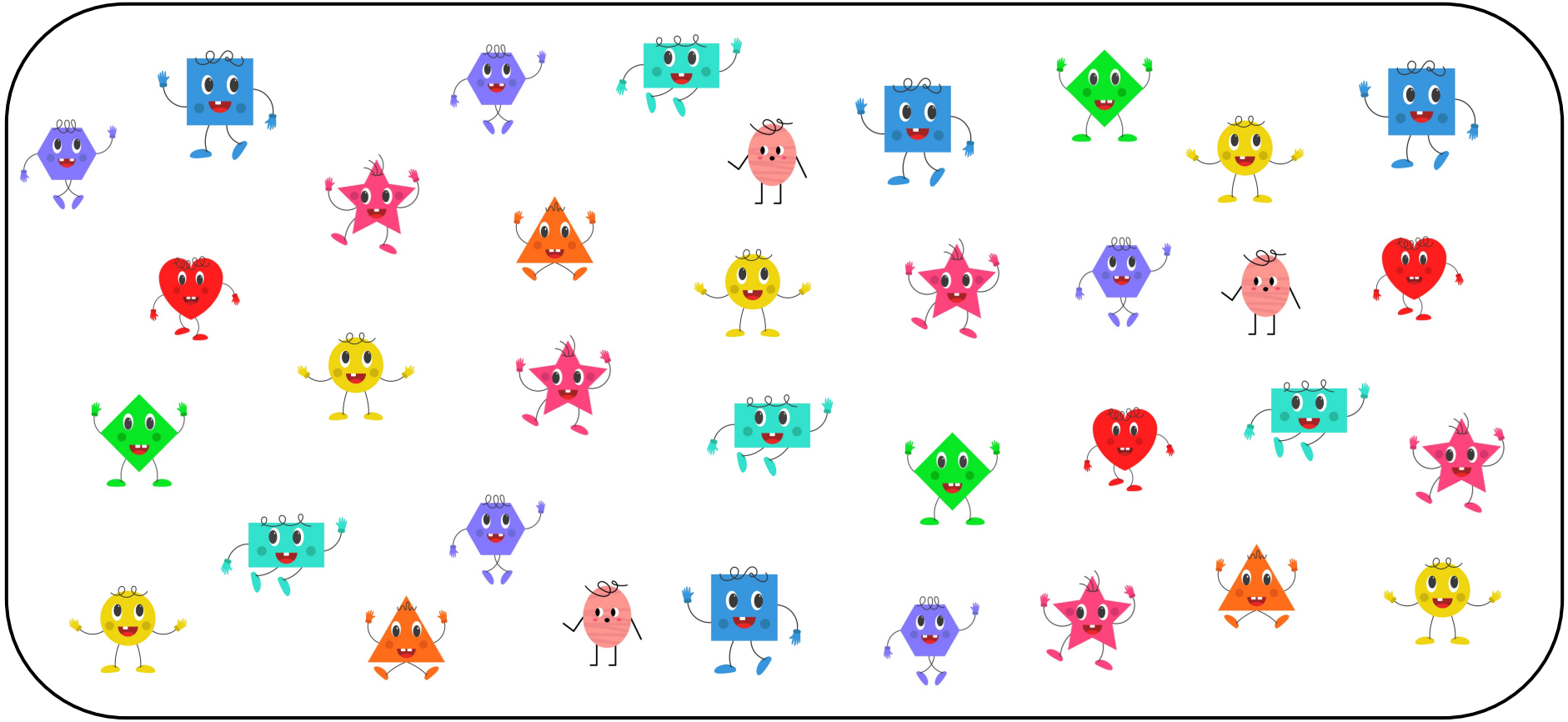
Focus on **counting** and **simple sentences**.

After counting, ask students to say full sentences.

- “I see three triangles.”
- “There are five stars.”
- “How many circles can you see?”

Teacher Tips

Focus on **comparing and reasoning**.

Ask students to compare the numbers.

- Which shape appears the most?
- Which shape appears the least?
- Are there more stars or squares?

Optional challenge:

- How many more circles than ovals?
