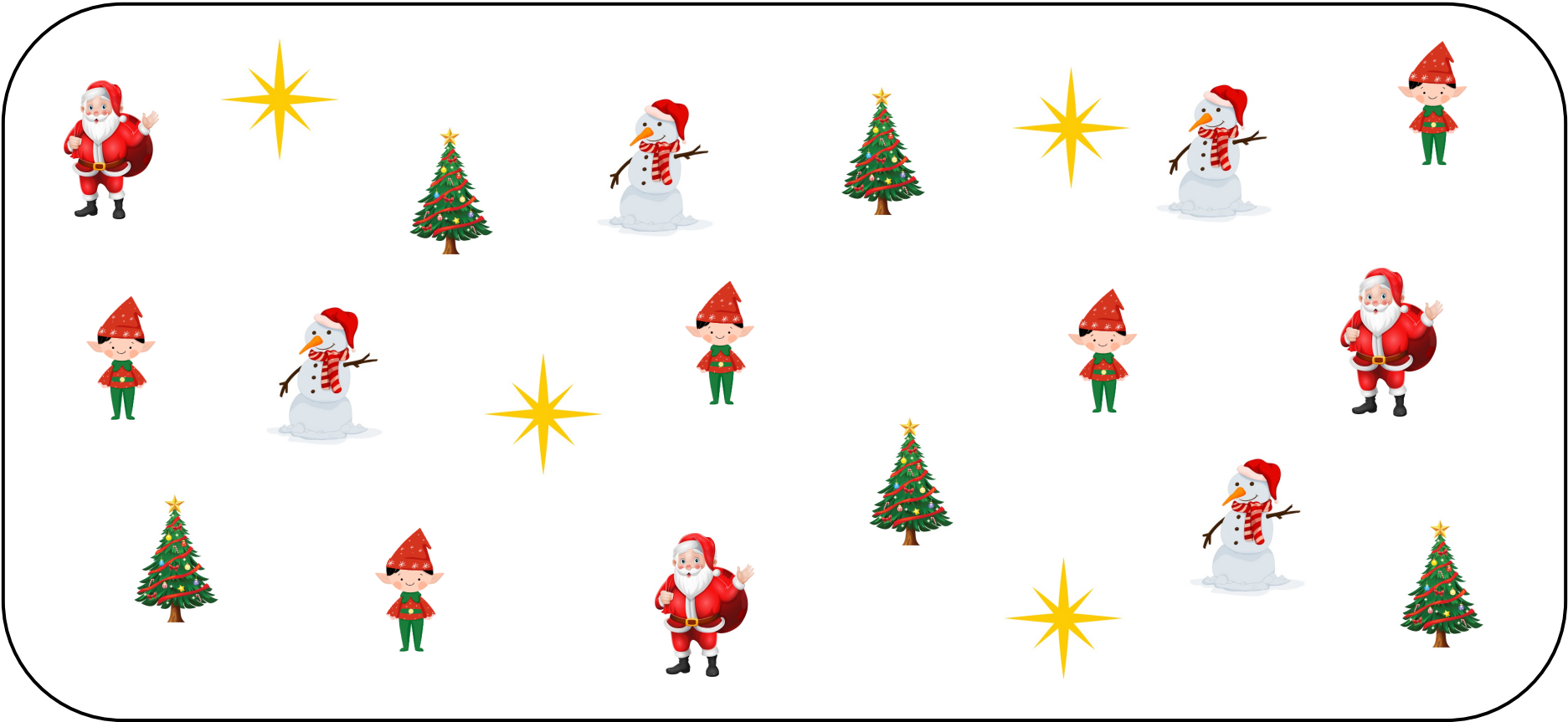


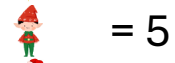
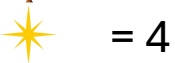
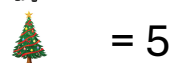
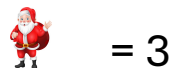
Instructions: Find and count the Christmas pictures

Teacher Tips

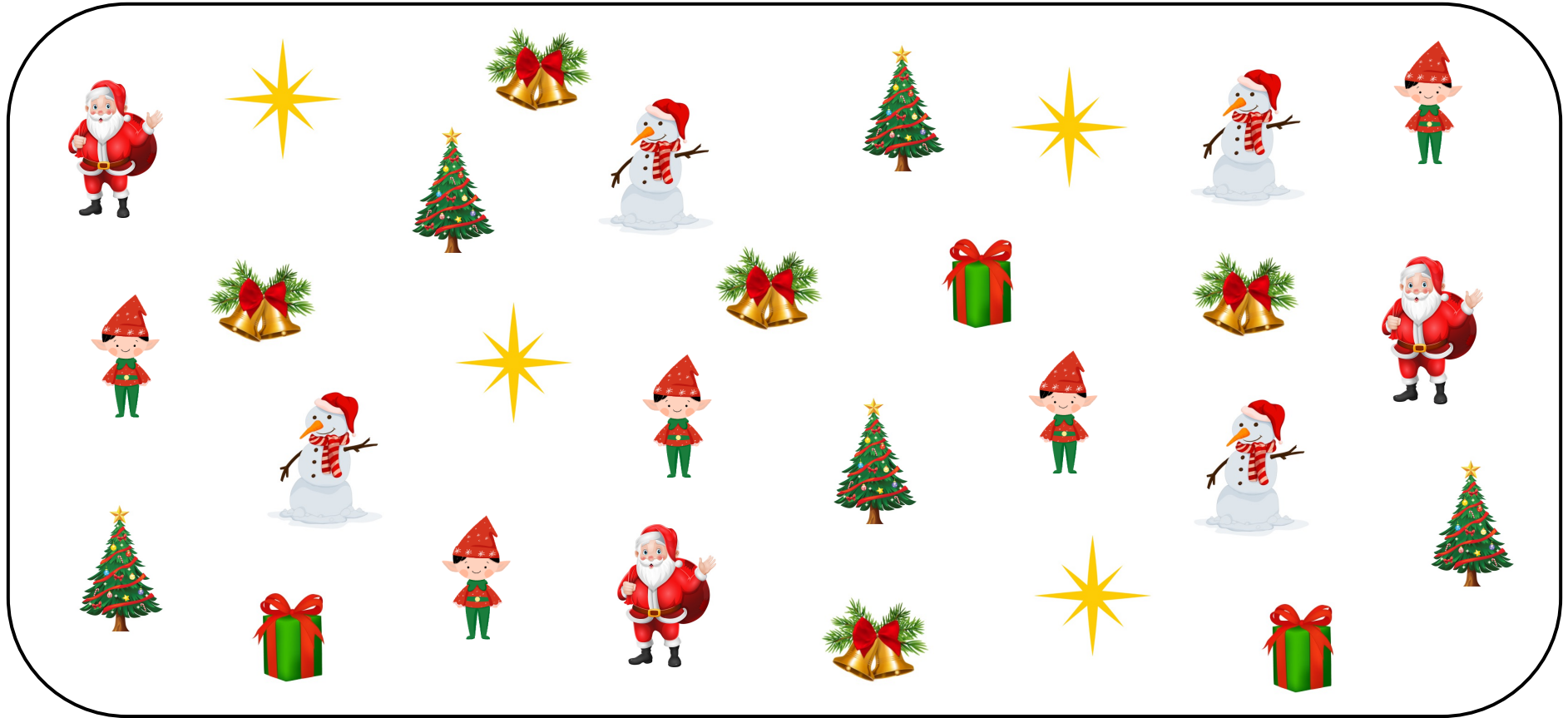
Ask students to point and say the Christmas picture.

Teacher Tips

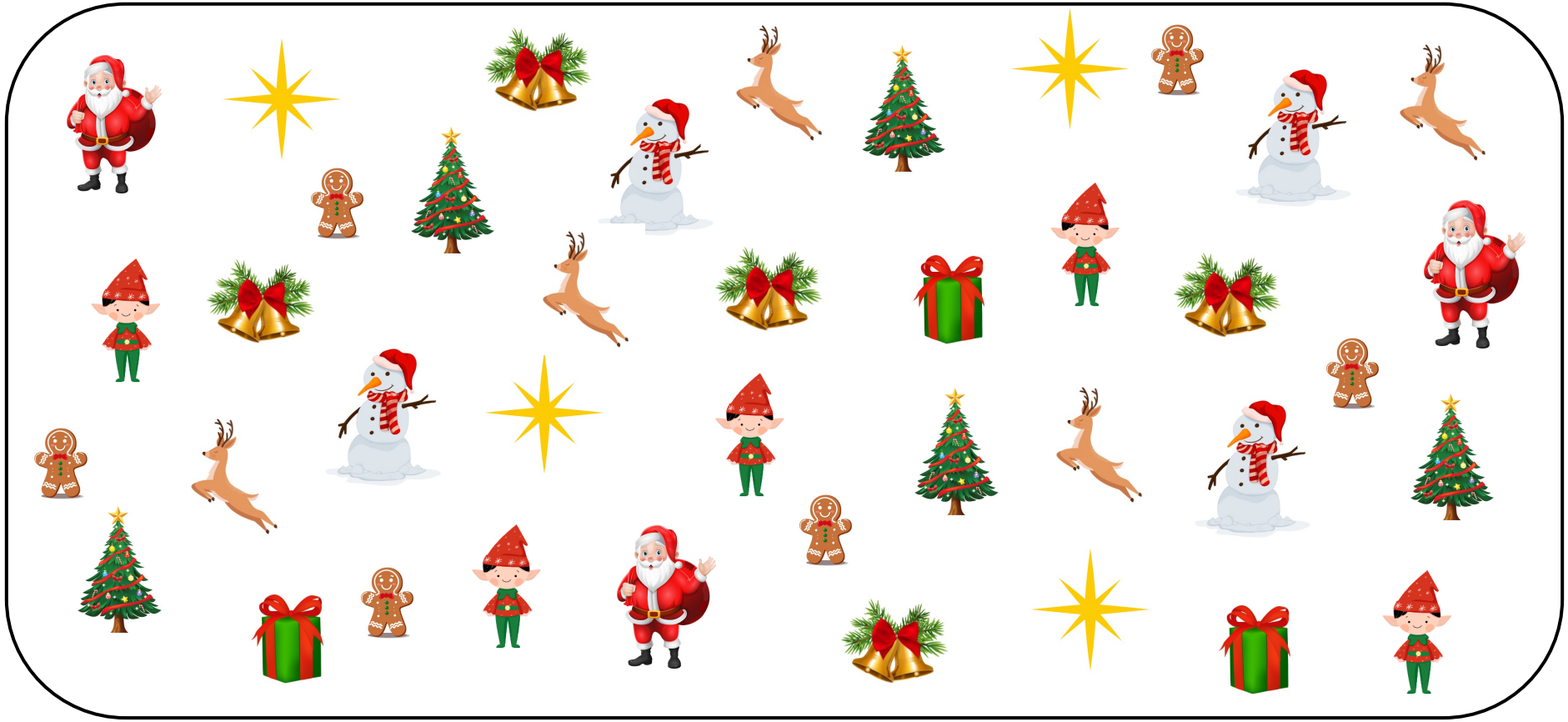
Focus on **counting and simple sentences**.

After counting, ask students to say full sentences.

- “I see three Santas.”
- “There are four stars.”
- “How many presents can you see?”

Teacher Tips

Focus on **comparison and critical thinking**.

Ask students to compare the numbers.

- Which object appears the most?
- Which picture appears the least?
- Are there more elves or presents?
