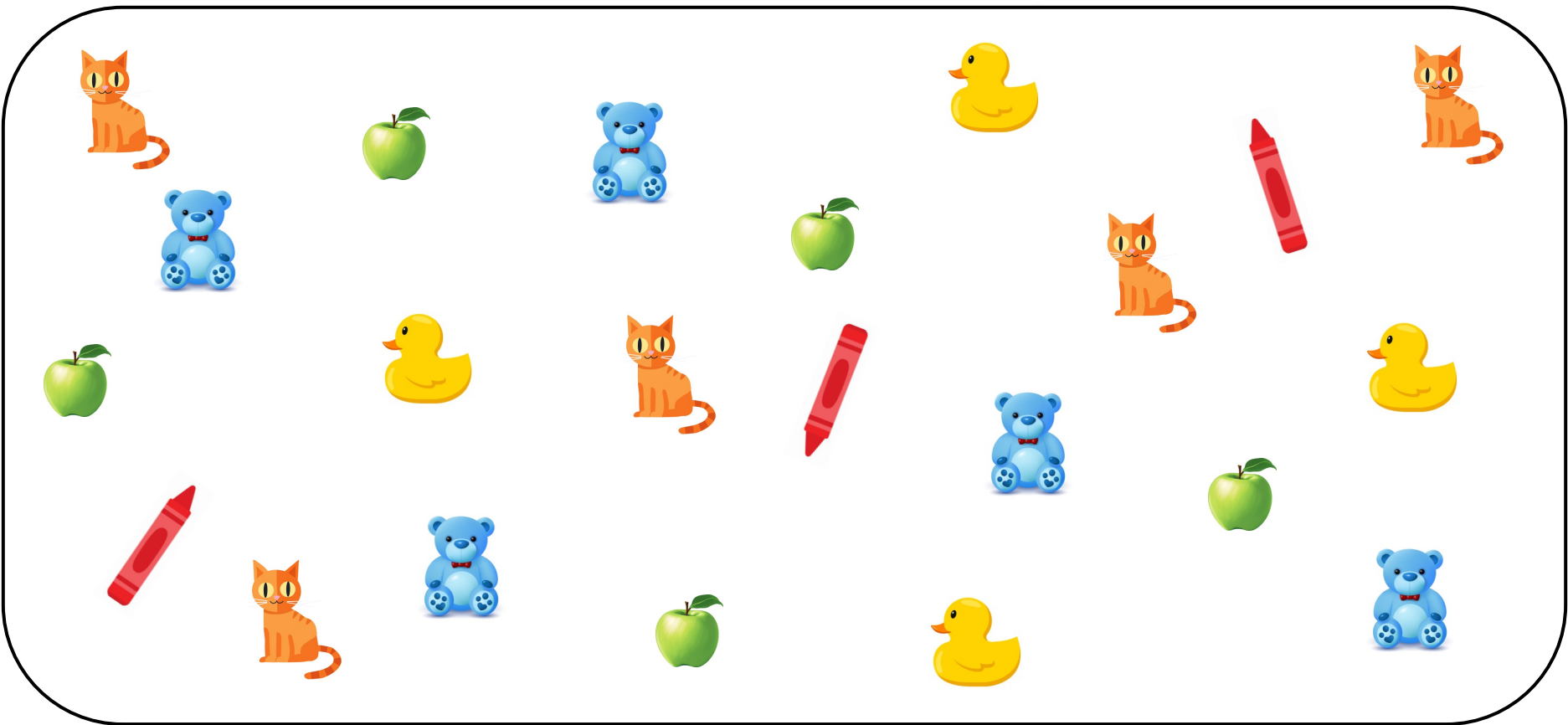


Instructions: Find and count the coloured objects.

Teacher Tips

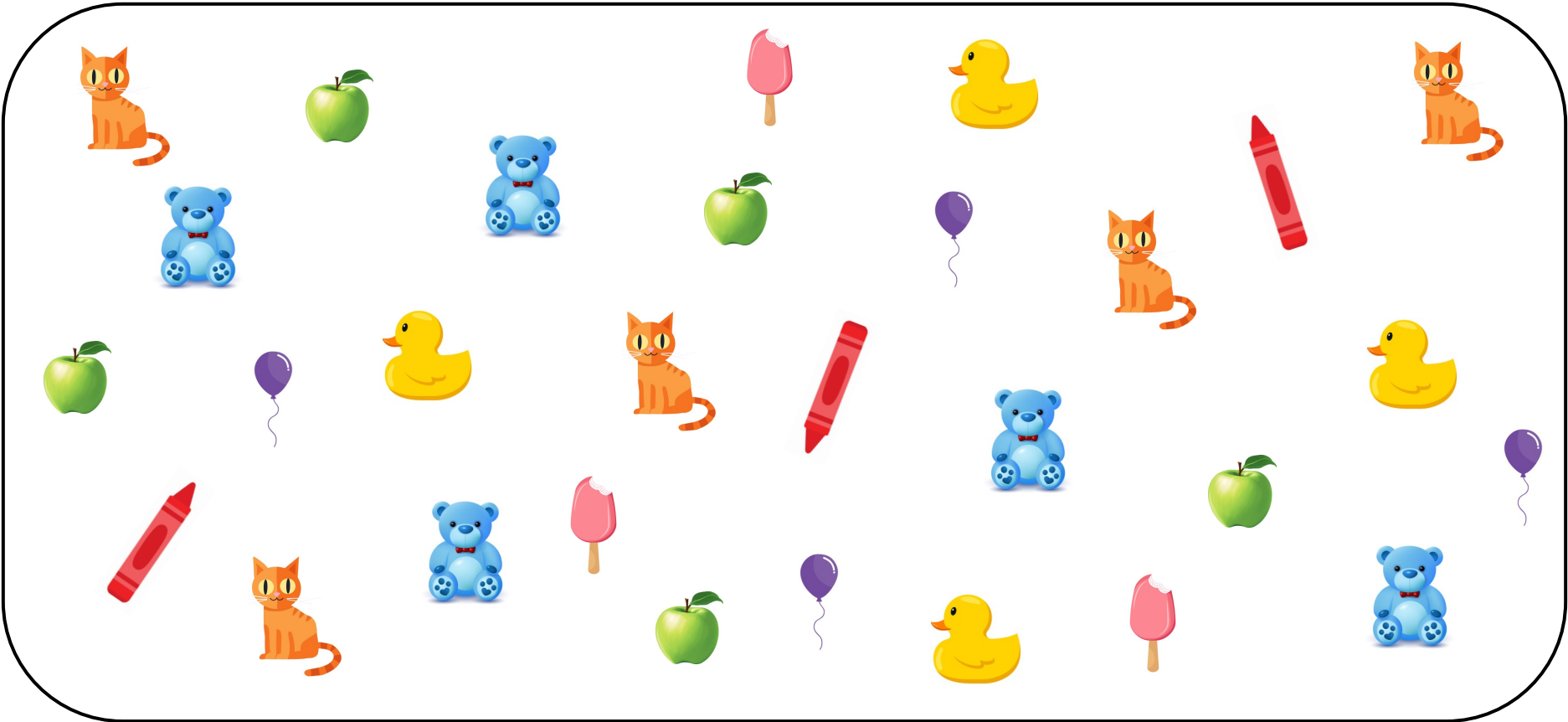
Ask students to point to a picture and tell you the colour.

- “Find a red crayon.”
- “Where is the yellow duck?”
- “Show me an orange cat.”

Teacher Tips

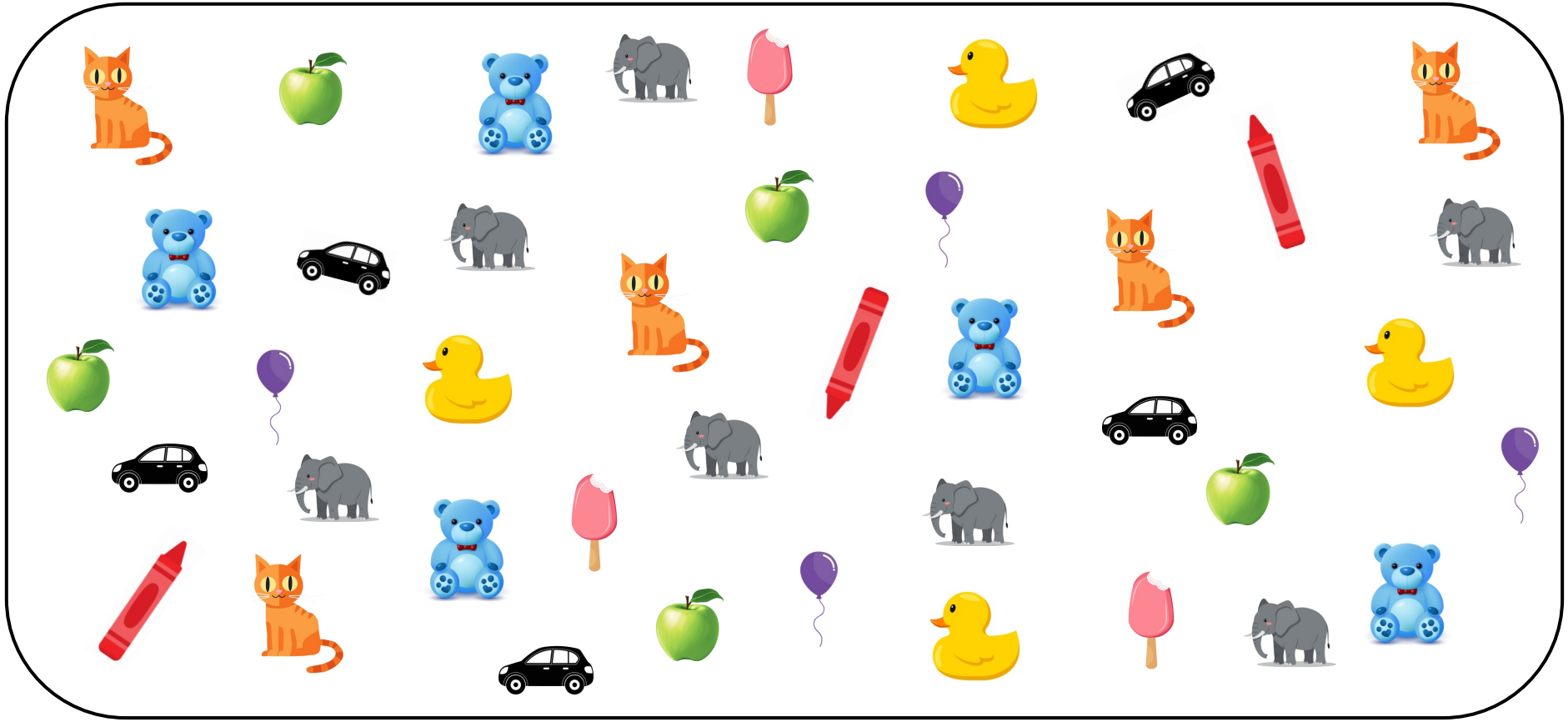
Focus on **counting and simple sentences**.

After counting, ask students to say full sentences.

- “I see three red crayons.”
- “There are five green apples.”
- “How many purple balloons can you see?”

Teacher Tips

Focus on **comparing and reasoning**.

Ask students to compare the numbers.

- Which coloured object appears the most?
- Which coloured object appears the least?
- Are there more black cars or green apples?

Optional challenge:

- How many more blue teddy bears than purple balloons?
